

## Anatomy & Physiology 12

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
### Description

The human body is the focus of this course. As you learn the body's biochemistry, anatomy and physiology, you will be challenged with the bigger question of how the different parts of the body interrelate at the molecular and organ system levels to maintain health.

### Resources

Lessons and assessments are online and use a combination of text and short videos, interactive animated exercises and links to websites to help you understand the concepts.



Optional Resource: The textbook '*Inquiry into Life*' by Sylvia Mader (10<sup>th</sup> Ed.) is a **NOT required** but some students may want to use it as a resource. The \$100 textbook deposit is fully refunded once you complete the course and return it within one year.

### Assessment

Your understanding is assessed through Module Tests (~60%), unit quizzes (~10%) and projects (~30%). Each of the 11 units ends with a quiz that can be written from home. Each unit also has project work. The 5 Module Tests are password-protected, so they must be written at a supervised location.

Students residing outside the metro Vancouver area can arrange through their course instructor for remote proctoring at another educational location.

Note: The expectation is that students will complete their online course within a 5 month period of time. Consult your teacher if additional time is needed.
