

Hello K-8 Online Parents/Guardians:

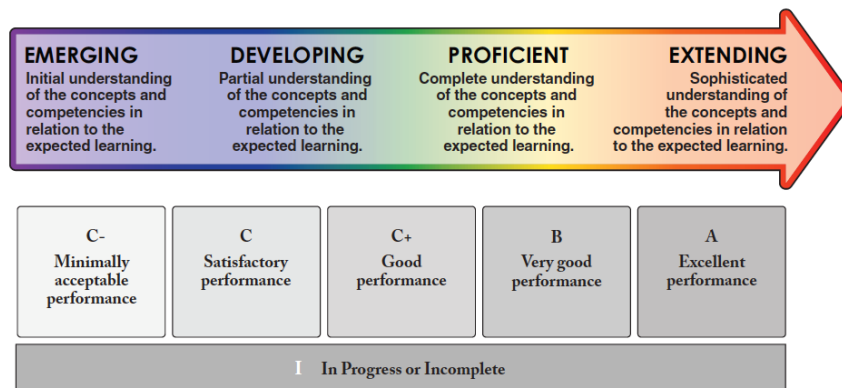

This Report Card contains information about your child’s work habits and engagement in the K-8 Online Program, as well as comments and marks related to their progress in learning. Please note that all children learn and develop at different rates and times, and we will continue to support students to make progress from whatever point they are at in their learning.

For our K-5 families, your child will receive a comment and a proficiency scale for Term 1. The new Ministry of Education proficiency scales are EMG-Emerging, DEV-Developing, PRF-Proficient and EXT-Extending. Parents/guardians of Grade 4 and 5 students who are new to the proficiency scales may speak to their teacher and request a letter grade if they wish. For our Grade 6-8 families, you will continue to receive a comment and a letter grade to indicate progress.

Report Card comments will focus on what your child knows, can do and understands in each curricular area. All students will receive, at minimum, a comment and a mark for English Language Arts and Mathematics. For some students who have experienced challenges working online, there may not be enough evidence of student work in the other curricular areas to provide a mark at this time and only a comment will be available.
