



Foundations and Pre-Calculus Math 10 (Adult)

This course is designed for adult students preparing for their math 11 requirement for Adult Graduation or for graduated adult students who just need to refresh or review concepts necessary for Pre-calculus Math 11 or Foundations of Math 11.

The course is divided into three modules. The first two modules are a review of basic principles including fractions, decimals, integers, algebra, order of operations, polynomials, graphing. The third module includes arithmetic series, trigonometry, roots and powers, factoring, relations and functions, linear functions, and systems of equations.

Prerequisites

Math 9, an assessment or permission of an instructor or counselor is required.

Learning Materials

All materials are provided within the course. Brief videos explain each concept and worksheets (with answer keys) provide practice. Worksheets can be printed as needed. Help is available by email, online as well as in-person (by appointment).

Assessment

Students may be asked at any time to complete testing on site under the supervision of a teacher.

Practice tests give students feedback to inform their learning, and they can be written either after the unit lessons or before the lessons to help the student decide if study of the material is necessary.

Since this course is intended for adult students as preparation for Pre-calculus Math 11, all tests can be written from home. Tests comprise 100% of the final grade.
