Course Title and Grade: Literary Studies 10

Course Description

Literary Studies 10 is designed for students who are interested in the literature of a particular era, geographical area, or theme, or in the study of literature in general. The course allows students to delve more deeply into literature as they explore specific themes, periods, authors, or areas of the world through literary works in a variety of media. Giving students the choice of a range of literary topics allows them to follow their passion.

Course Expectation

Students are expected to login regularly. Two-credit courses are to be completed in approximately two months. Some testing will be done under the supervision of a teacher.
